Who To Treat-Positive Biopsy

The oncotype DX[®] test is a test conducted on tissue that was collected during a biopsy. It is used to provide a personalized risk assessment and likelihood of favorable pathology to aid in the decision for active surveillance or immediate treatment.

Science:

The oncotype DX[®] assay looks at 17 genes within 4 pathways (androgen signaling, stromal response, cellular organization proliferation) to assess tumor aggressiveness in NCCN very low, low & intermediate risk patients.

Results:

Genomic Prostate Score (GPS) indicates the likelihood patient will be free from high grade cancer and cancer outside of the prostate.

GPS is reflective of the entire prostate at the time of biopsy.
