Who To Biopsy

The *phi* score is a blood test for men with a PSA result between 4-10ng/ml (some experts use it with PSA results from 2-10ng/ml). It is used to help reduce unnecessary initial prostate cancer biopsies.

Science:

The *phi* Score, which has three times the specificity for prostate cancer compared to the PSA alone. It is a calculation based on an index of proteins in the blood that combines the concentrations of PSA, freePSA and pro2PSA.

Results:

phi results have four categories of risk that prostate cancer may be found on biopsy.
