## 4Kscore<sup>®</sup>

### Who To Biopsy

The **4Kscore<sup>®</sup>** is a blood test that is combined with clinical information (like abnormal PSA or DRE) for men. It is used to determine who should undergo an initial or repeat prostate cancer biopsy.

#### Science:

Laboratory test measuring 4 kallikreins in the blood (Total PSA, Free PSA, Intact PSA and hK2) and combined with the patient's clinical information in an algorithm to predict the individual patient's risk of having aggressive prostate cancer versus indolent or no cancer.



#### Results:

- 4K Test results provide percent probability (positive predictive value) of an individual patient's risk of having aggressive prostate cancer on biopsy.
- 4Kscore Test stratifies the risk of the development of metastases and prostate cancer mortality in men 20 years later.
