Who To Re-Biopsy

ConfirmMDx[®] is a test conducted on tissue that was collected during a biopsy for patients who have had a negative prostate cancer biopsy or high grade pin was found. It is used to determine if a repeat biopsy is needed and if so to help target where to biopsy.

Science:

ConfirmMDx[®] is a three-gene methylation assay to detect an epigenetic field effect or halo effect given off by cancer at the DNA level.

Results:

A negative ConfirmMDx[®] result allows patients to avoid repeat biopsy and monitor with routine screening.

A positive ConfirmMDx[®] result shows suspicious areas marked as positive providing a guide for where to target during a repeat biopsy.
