Who To Biopsy

The **4Kscore[®]** is a blood test that is combined with clinical information (like abnormal PSA or DRE) for men. It is used to determine who should undergo an initial or repeat prostate cancer biopsy.

Science:

The **4Kscore[®]** measures 4 kallikreins in the blood (Total PSA, Free PSA, Intact PSA and hK2) and combines it with the patient's clinical information in an algorithm.

Results:

The **4Kscore[®]** predicts a patient's risk of having high grade prostate cancer versus indolent or no cancer on a biopsy.
